1. Before arrival

1-1 IMPORTANT Please submit your itinerary, including flight schedule.

1-2 IMPORTANT We will arrange the shuttle service between Kansai Airport and Tombo (accommodation), if you desired. It costs about 3500yen (one way).

The accommodation (Tombo) is located closed to the Demachiyana station, Keihan Line. The detailed information will be available in the internet.

1-3 We recommend you to bring at least 100USD in cash. The payment in Japan is usually accepted only in cash (Japanese YEN).

1-4 We also recommend that you purchase travel insurance for your trip.

2. During the seminar

2-1 Scholarship (80,000yen) will be divided into three payments. One is for your accommodation. Our staff will pay it in advance. The second part (about 10,000yen) will be paid at the opening. It is for your daily life during your staying Kyoto. The balance will be paid at the end of seminar.

2-2 You do not need to study on the energy science in advance, but please check some information of energy supply and demand in your country. Of course, you must bring the writing implements.

2-3 You must participate the whole of program. You cannot skip any of the activity.

2-4 The updated schedule will be appeared in the attached file.

2-5 At the first day (16th, Monday), we will bring you to the seminar room from your accommodation in the morning. It takes about 10min walk. We will pick you up at 8:30 AM.

2-6 Meals are not included in the program. Its can be taken at the campus cafeteria or off-campus restaurant. It costs about 400-500yen per meal.

3. At the end of seminar (21st)

We will issue a certificate of attendance for each attendee. We will pay the rest of scholarship as mentioned above.

4. General information

Kyoto's weather in this season is very cold comparing with ASEAN countries. The temperatures in these days are 0 to 7 degrees centigrade. Please bring a warm jacket or coat. You may experience snowing Kyoto. Japan is one of safety country but please take care your personal belongings at the outside of campus, the airport and accommodation.
